Happy New Year from Alakara Home!

I arrived back in Moroto on 23 Dec after 2 months away in NZ. Was great to be back with my girls – lots of hugs all around!! We now have 39 girls. One is working; 4 will finish 2-year courses this year, 10 have been at boarding high school and the rest at Primary. All are doing well in their studies and also personal growth.



School progress – 16 buildings roofed; 5 plastered

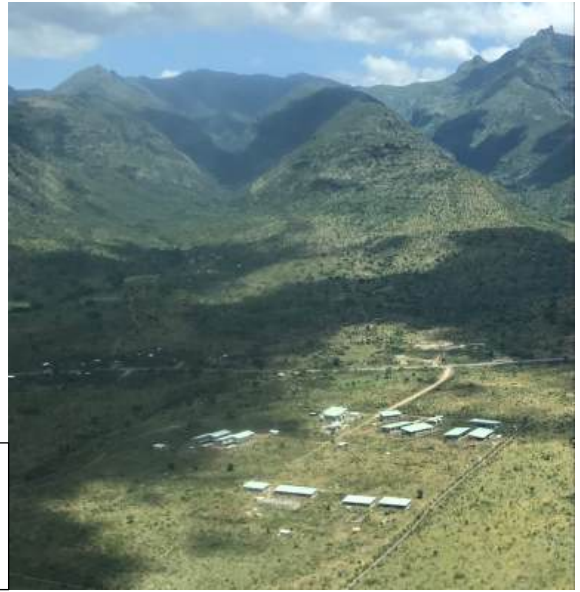


Our biggest building – the assembly hall (40m x 24m) – was finally roofed using steel trusses and a very strong crane!!! This will hold up to 800 people. Five of the sixteen buildings have been plastered outside and most of the joinery for all buildings have been made. Our next steps are internal roading, paving, more power connections, plumbing, plastering inside and out of all buildings, flooring and of course the fit-out – bunks, chairs, desks, lockers, administration furniture, kitchen appliances, library books etc etc.

WE ARE LOOKING FOR FUNDING TO COMPLETE OUR SCHOOL SO WE CAN OPEN FEB 2026. CAN YOU HELP?
