



Alakara is now 9!!!

We opened the doors of Alakara Home 9 years ago on 30/5/15 with 18 girls. We now have 38 girls and here we are in front of the hall building at our school site. There is a lot of thankfulness and joy from us all for what God has done in all our lives. The girls are well and progressing in their studies at primary, high school and tertiary courses!!! All the course girls now have long hair!!!



School progress – 14 out of 16 buildings roofed!



BUT we still need funds to complete – can you help?

Great progress has been made in the 23 months since construction started with the building of a stone fence around our 50 acres and the initial private donations of NZ\$2.5m is now running out and further funding is being sought. On-going work will need to be put on hold from mid September unless fresh funds come in. We are seeking approximately NZ\$1M to complete Phase 1 of the project, allowing us to open the school for 160 year 1 girls in January 2026. We are praying this vision will be a part of your vision and you might consider gifting towards this project. To assist, several key construction items are detailed below with costings that may help you identify the size of the amounts we are seeking and sponsorship of any singular construction component would be most welcome.

Our immediate requirements are:

- Internal roading and sports field creation – NZ\$165,000
- Plastering/painting/joinery/flooring of 3 classes & Admin – NZ\$35,000 ea – (total 4 x)
- As per above – Assembly/Dining/Canteen/Café Building – NZ\$66,000
- As per above – 2 x 2-storey dormitories – NZ\$42,000 ea (total 2 x)
- As per above – Library and Staff Room Buildings – NZ\$11,000 ea (total 2 x)
- As per above – 2 Pit Latrines and 1 Toilet Block – NZ\$18,000 for all 3
- As per above – 5 Teachers Housings blocks (4 units in each) – NZ\$36,000 ea (total 5 x)
- 2 Containers to site to become our workshop/store – NZ\$11,000
- Outfitting costs of all buildings – desks, chairs, bunks, kitchen, etc – NZ\$176,000
- 60,000 ltr water retention – underground concrete tank – NZ\$40,000 or 6 x 10,000 ltr plastic tanks above ground – NZ\$12,000 (prefer concrete option)
- Signage and building graphics – NZ\$10,000; Pathways, paving etc – NZ\$15,000
- Filling 7 sock pits with stones and pipe – NZ\$7,000
