We are now totaling 3.5 soccer teams – 39!!! – with 3 new girls in the last few months. We are basically at capacity! The girls are all well and progressing at school. I have now been here 21 months and probably another 21 to go! I feel at home both with the girls and the community so that is good – but I do miss friends/family and food!!!! ©



What's been happening!!? 1) 3 new girls to Alakara Home

Three new girls came in August this year – Scovia – 8; Lydia -7; and "Miss Melody"!! – 5! All are orphans. One has a lame grandmother who cannot care for her and the others have no relatives. They are very happy to be in Alakara Home and learning how to be part of a big family.







2) 4 groups of visitors!!

Our visitors were all fantastic!!! My great friends Andrew & Karen came dancing and kissing the girls – which they loved!!!

Jessica, James & Adelaide flew in and out but loved what they saw. Sophie & Michael were special visitors - Sophie ran our first and only fundraisers 12 years ago and now she saw the fruit of her labour! Elisabeth and Georgia heard about Alakara Home and wanted to come. They taught the girls career guidance and played till they dropped with the younger ones!! Legends!!!









3) 10 school buildings up!!! - from this to this in 1 year!!









It has been an **amazing journey** – this building of a boarding high school for girls just 7km out of Moroto. It has been filled with excitement, frustration, some little annovance © and wonder as we have seen our site go from wild thorny brush to a site with currently 10 buildings at roofing stage and a gorgeous 2m high stone wall around our 50 acres – which is the pride of joy of not only me but the community!

Currently we have **Elliot** – a water engineer from Beca, Auckland – who has come for 3 months to assist me and Robert my engineer. He's been fantastic – so willing to help and going the extra mile for sure – seems to like to get his hands dirty also!

We have planted a 'forest' of 1300 trees and an orchard of 260 mangoes, quavas and avocado with more to come! There are 3 toilet/shower blocks to build along with 8-10 teachers housing blocks, a huge amount of landscaping and planting of trees and the making of a road around our perimeter and flattening the sports field!! So not too much more to do!!! ©

We do not have all the **funding** required to finish so if anyone has won lotto or has a spare million please get in touch with me. We, and the community, are excited about what this school will provide to not just our region but all of Uganda. We are told to prepare for 1000 students!!! There won't be a school like our school!!! Name still to be decided!! ©
